LMSW's tend to work in case management for children or people seeking public assistance. They also tend to work under a licensed clinical social worker, psychiatrist, or a psychologist. Some states will only license social workers who hold a master's degree.

Social work bachelor's programs provide a comprehensive overview of the field. Students typically learn about case management, community and program organization, and utilizing community resources. Undergraduate social work students acquire essential skills for client advocacy, crisis response, and treatment design.

Step 2: Earn a Bachelor of Science in Social Work. Your first step towards becoming a social worker should be acquiring a bachelor's degree in social work, which is the minimum educational requirement. A typical program of study will include classes such as social welfare policy, social work ethics and values, diversity, social work research, biology laboratory, foreign language and state and local government. With a bachelor's degree, you'll be eligible for entry-level social work positions.
